## Team Gill/Hewitt Close Out European Tour with Sixth Event Win

Released 4 March 2025 – Tahli Gill and Dean Hewitt have wrapped up the European portion of their season in dominant fashion, going undefeated (7-0) to win the Word Curling Tour (WCT) Hvidovre Mixed Doubles Cup 2025 in Denmark. The 20-team field featured strong international competition, including three national champions—Denmark, Spain, and Finland—who will

compete at this year's World Championships.

This marks the duo's sixth event win and eighth podium finish of the 2024/25 season. Across their European tour, they secured two titles, a fifth-place finish, and a 17-2 record against some of the best teams on the continent.

"We've been really pleased with the team's consistency and execution throughout this stretch of the season," said National Head Coach Perry Marshall. "Building momentum against strong international competition is invaluable, and the support of the AIS European Training Centre in Italy has provided them with world-class facilities to maintain their high-performance standards while competing abroad."
