



Curling Australia Announces Milano Cortina 2026 Nomination Criteria

15 April 2025 – Curling Australia has officially released the *Nomination Criteria for the Milano Cortina 2026 Olympic Winter Games*, setting out the process by which athletes may be nominated for selection to the Australian Olympic Team.

The criteria, developed in line with the Australian Olympic Committee (AOC) Olympic Team Nomination and Selection By-Law, will guide the identification and nomination of athletes across the Men's, Women's, and Mixed Doubles disciplines.

Athletes must satisfy several eligibility requirements, as outlined in the Nomination Criteria and the AOC's Olympic Team Nomination and Selection By-Law, including:

- Satisfying the Qualification System for Curling as set out by World Curling;
- · Being an Australian citizen and a member of Curling Australia;
- Respecting and complying with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code, and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions.
