

Expression of Interest – Member Representative for Nominations Committee

As part of Curling Australia's commitment to strong governance and transparent decision-making, we are seeking expressions of interest (EOI) for a Member Representative to serve on the Nominations Committee (NomCo) for the upcoming term.

The NomCo plays a crucial role in overseeing and recommending candidates for elected Director positions on the Curling Australia Board, ensuring a fair, independent, and merit-based selection process.

In accordance with the NomCo Terms of Reference, only one (1) Member Representative will be appointed to the Committee for the upcoming term. If only one eligible nomination is received, that individual will be appointed. If multiple nominations are received, the process outlined in the Terms of Reference will be followed.

Eligibility Criteria for Member Representative

To be considered for this role, nominees must:

- Be an active member of a Member State;
- Demonstrate an understanding of governance, sport administration, or selection processes;
- Commit to acting in the best interests of Curling Australia and all Member States, rather than solely representing their own Member State; and
- Declare any conflicts of interest that may arise in their role on the Nominations Committee.
